Accommodations;

At Patricia Lake we look after our staff and their comfort. You are part of a team providing first class guest service and first class accommodations to visitors from around the world so we want you to feel appreciated and be relaxed in your home away from home. We have 2 separate staff cabins...one is a rustic log cabin and the other is newer and more modern. Rooms are assigned on first come first served basis, typically most individuals want the log cabin!

Your onsite housing is non-smoking , roomy three bedroom units with large full kitchens and two bathrooms. Kitchens are fully equipped with coffeemaker, toaster, dishes, cutlery, pots and pans. We have bedding, linen, towels, and all other essentials for self catered living. All you need to bring is yourself. The kitchen/living common areas have cable TV, DVD, and free Wi-Fi. Located outside the cabin is a private outdoor fire pit for staff campfires and story-telling. This is place where friendships are made that last forever.

Staff housing is free for Patricia Lake Staff only. There are no extra deductions off of your pay-check at the end of the month.

Living in Jasper National Park: The Park offers a huge variety of activities and adventures like world class white-water rafting, local cliff-jumping, fantastic hiking, spectacular views, raging rapids and towering waterfalls. As a group or individually our staff take tours to Mt. Edith Cavell which is an unbelievable glacier fed lake complete with iceberg! The Jasper Tramway gives our staff free passes for a view from the top and Maligne Lake Tours will often offer our staff a discounted price to tour the Lake and Spirit Island.
